Short description of the infrastructure / laboratory

The Hydrogen production Performance characterization Facility (H2PF) comprises of a small scale hydrogen production unit (reformer) based on reforming of low calorific natural gas to high purity hydrogen as fuel cell feed and an online monitoring of reformer input and output fluid and energy streams to survey quality of feeds and products and to determine performance in terms of efficiency and CO2 emissions under various operation modes. So far, very little research is ongoing to support the definition of test protocols and their experimental validation on the energy conversion and environmental performance of small scale reformers.
